What has been happening since our previous Newsletter?

Council Matters

- Warwick District Council (WDC) met with Chairs of our local Parish Councils; District Councillors and representatives from KHSR in September.
WDC senior planning officers outlined progress regarding the South Warwickshire Local Plan (SWLP) and in particular the selection of preferred sites. Our representatives explained why the Arkwright proposal is fraught with delivery problems, including prohibitively high costs relating to infrastructure. All Councillors and WDC officials welcomed our views and requested copies of our Interim Report which we have now delivered. You can read the Interim Report on the KHSR website.
- Indications are that the list of Preferred Sites is likely to be released by WDC before Christmas.
- The SWLP, including our Interim Report, will be on the Agenda of Shrewley and Hatton Parish Councils.
